If the documents are not in English or Korean, they must be notarized in English or Korean and submitted to International Office at YJC</p>

All applicants must fill out the application form correctly and the other documents including admission application must be handed in via e-mail [yjcinternational2020@gmail.com](mailto:yjcinternational2020@gmail.com)

All the necessary documentation should be in English or Korean. The other languages must be translated and notarized into English or Korean. Especially, official documentation, such as Diploma, certification of the expectant graduation, Transcript(s), must be notarized at Korean Embassy (Consul) for ascertaining the truth.

Once your application is completed, the International Affairs will then contact you individually to make an appointment for an interview and the following schedule. Admitted applicants must pass through the medical checkup in Korea and only after completing registration charge the applicants finally can be YJC students.

## II. Academy Guide for International Students

### 1. Foreign Language Class

Basically, most of classes at the YJC are taught in Korean, but for the international students who are lack of Korean YJC provides some courses in English and Chinese as well.

### 2. Enrollment Fee & Tuition Fee

Admission fee is equally ₩763,000 (approx. \$724) for all faculties and tuition is different depending on the schools. International Students are able to receive 30% discount on the tuition fee and to relieve the burden of the expense the self-funded student can pay their tuition fee in three month installments. For the payment in installments, International Affairs' approval is needed.

### 3. Dormitory

#### 1) Off-campus dormitory

- Students will reside in flats located within commuting distance (approximately 20 minutes) of the college. Each flat has one to two bedrooms per room but mainly two bedrooms are assigned.
- In dormitory fee, utility fees(W15,000, approx. \$14) are included such as gas and electricity, however, Students might be in charge of the actual fee once every 6 months to cover the actual utility expenses.
- The college supports 50% subsidy for your utility bill every month.
- Before entering the dormitory, students must deposit W300,000(approx. \$280). This will cover the damaged property(furniture, flooring etc.) and unpaid utility fees. If it will not happen, you will be fully refunded when you leave.

#### 2) On-campus dormitory

- On-campus dormitory is given a priority to Korean students and scholarship students. International students can be limitedly allowed depending on the situation.
- In dormitory fee, utility fees(W20,000, approx. \$18) are included such as gas and electricity, however It must be paid once every four (4) months.
