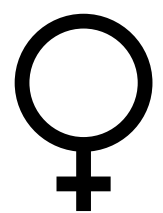

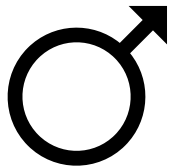

50 years, 4 schools



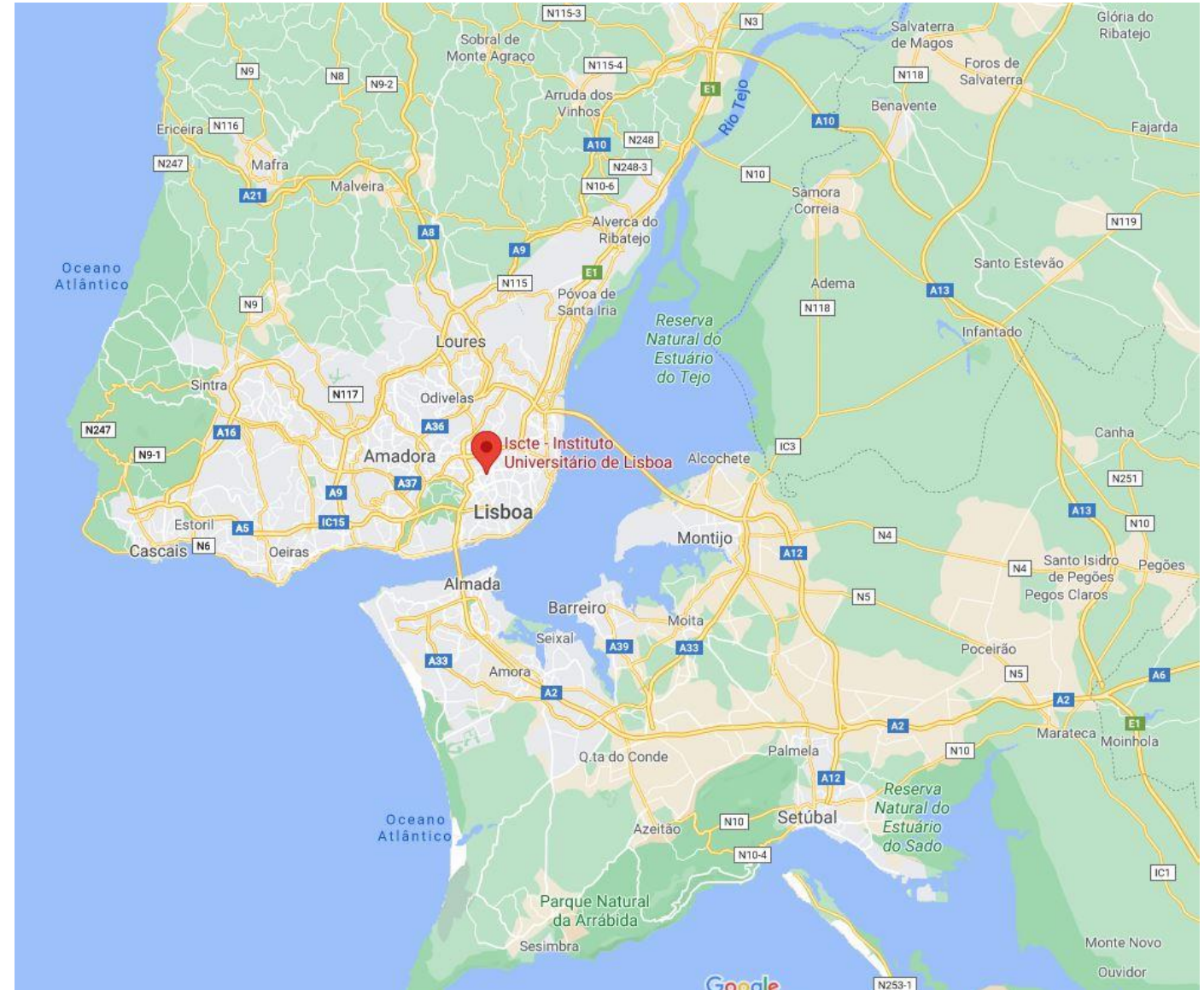
- The Iscte - University Institute of Lisbon was founded in 1972 as one of Portugal's first modern universities, with the central aim of studying labour and social dynamics in a rapidly changing world.
- Since its establishment, the university has expanded its disciplinary reach into four schools:
 - **School of Sociology and Public Policy**
 - **School of Social Sciences**
 - **Iscte Business School**
 - **School of Technology and Architecture**
- On campus, students find not only a robust intellectual tradition, but also a vibrant, multicultural environment.

Iscte is located in the center of Lisbon, in an area that has ample green spaces, commerce and urban equipment.

It has direct and fast connections to the rest of the city by bike, bus and subway.

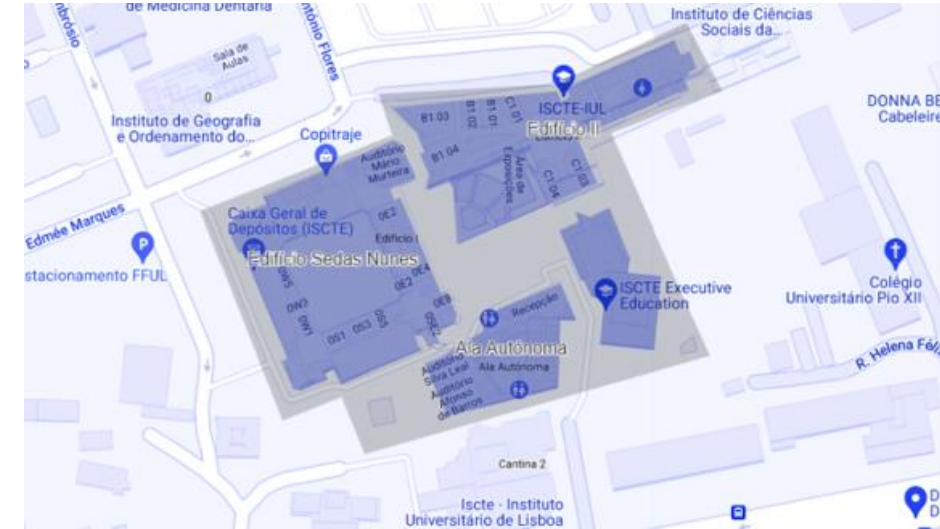
By train and bus you can access in half an hour the beach, promenade and residential areas of the entire metropolitan area.
