



ABOUT JYVÄSKYLÄ

- Population: 138 109 (about 1/3 are students)
- The landscape of Jyväskylä is varied with lakes, forests and hills within a walking distance of the city centre.
- Lots of bars, nightclubs and shopping possibilities
- In the winter The Laajavuori skiing centre and recreation area provide excellent opportunities for winter sports and other activities.
- Town is quite small, so most of the students move around by foot or bicycle
- Good public transport all around the area of Jyväskylä and to everywhere in Finland



HOW TO GET THERE?

• It is recommended to take either a ferry or an airplane to Finland (City of Helsinki, Turku or Tampere)

• The easiest/cheapest option to arrive to Jyväskylä is by buss or train from Helsinki, Turku or Tampere

100 – 200 eur

ACCOMODATION & FOOD

- The University of Jyväskylä reserves a limited quota of furnished study-bedrooms for exchange students from the Central Finland Student Housing Foundation, KOAS, and Soihtu Housing. Every student has their own room in shared apartments.
- KOAS offers apartments all around the Jyväskylä town area. Laundry rooms, saunas and storage rooms, as well as common rooms, are available in the buildings. All KOAS apartments have an Internet connection.
- The prices for a furnished single study-bedroom with a shared kitchen and shared bathroom ranges from 260 € to 360 € per month for a room in a shared apartment, and closer to 400 € for a studio in Soihtu. In both cases a furniture fee of about 15-25 €/month is added to the rent (furniture includes a bed, desk, chair, storage space).
- There are several canteens for students around the campus. One meal costs 2.95 eur.
